The **RIO** class is required as part of the application process for personnel interested in becoming a Primary Instructor for State Fire Training courses and a Registered Lead Evaluator for administering certification examinations. Potential instructors must submit their application to become registered instructors with State Fire Training within two (2) years of attendance. The course provides information on Primary Instructor responsibilities, accountability, and the registration process. An introduction to State Fire Training Procedures Manual, procedures for requesting/returning a CFSTES or FSTEP class and Primary Instructor application process assistance. (*Bring application documentation and instructors will help with your application.*)

The **Ethics** class is a one-day course designed to provide you with concepts and theories of the ethical decision-making process, help you recognize the signs of an ethical dilemma, identify advantages and disadvantages of ethical behavior, and an opportunity to review examples of classroom situations in which instructors used their leadership role to either encourage or discourage ethical behavior. Participants in this class will examine ethics, values, principles, and morality. State Fire Training's Instructor Code of Ethics/Conduct will also be presented. This course is required for Instructor, Registered Lead and Skills Evaluator certifications.
