These two documents are subject to slightly change between now and the first day of the class and will be discussed IN DEPTH on the first night of class – Thursday January 23, 2025 – and/or the second night of class – January 30, 2025.
- Please come prepared to ask AND answer questions based on those two documents because those two documents are your expectations and rules of engagement for the class.
- The **Student Contract** is there to ensure you are set up for success, and no completely what is expected of you to be successful. Simply put, failure to meet the expectations will result in your putting me in a position to have to drop you from the class. There are no surprises and everything is known up front so you can be as prepared as can be.
