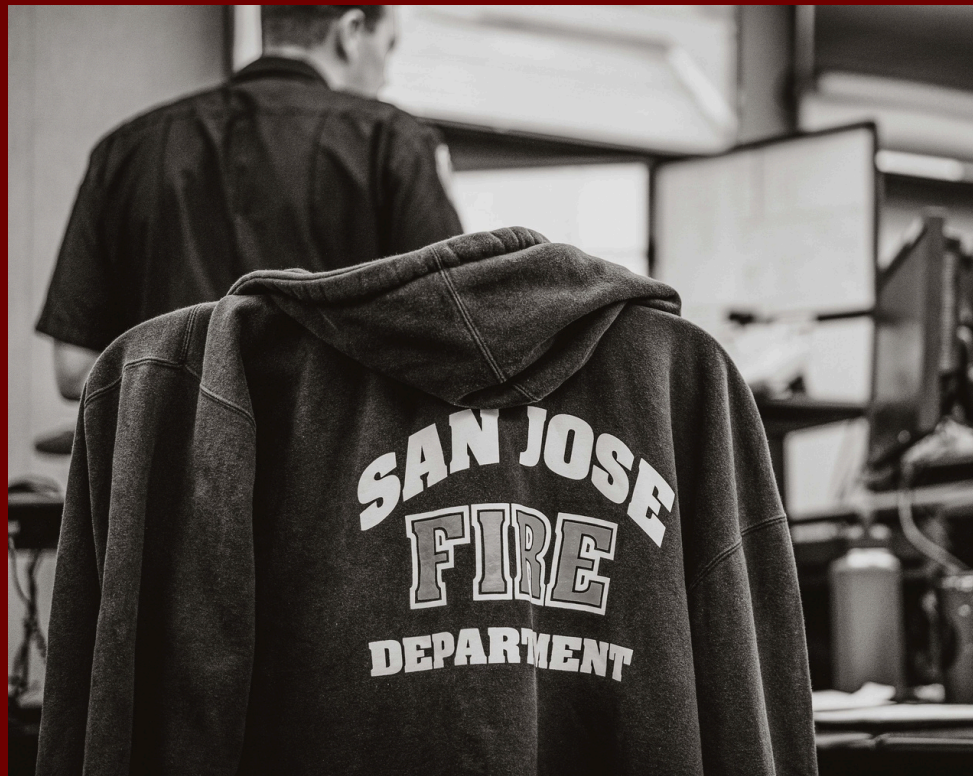

Trainees must successfully complete all formal academic and on-the-job training to be appointed to the class of PSRD and retain their employment.
